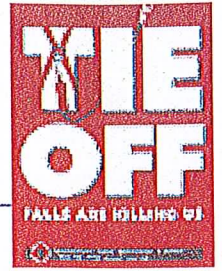


SAFETY BULLETIN

To all Bowie Employees,

Another fall has claimed the life of a restoration worker. On Thursday, February 18, a 43 year old restoration worker fell to his death while repairing balconies. Exact details of what he was doing at the time are not important at the moment. What is important is that you are working safely at all times. **DO NOT** take chances with your life to save a little time. Falls are killing far too many workers. It is quite simple, if there is a chance that you may fall, **TIE OFF!** Before every shift, inspect your fall protection equipment.

The safety of our employees is our top priority. Our health and safety policy states, '**No job is so important, no work order so critical, that we can't take the time to perform our work safely.**' You are the person most responsible for your own safety.
